Moja global Strategic Plan 2020

The four layers of the strategic plan are based on the Balanced Scorecard for non-profit organisations. The four layers should be read as building blocks where the last layer (Financial Resources) is the foundation on which the next layer, "moja global Organisation", is built. The "moja global software" layer is building on the "moja global organisation" and finally the software layer helps to achieve results layer which corresponds to the objectives of the organisation, i.e. widest possible use of and collaboration on open source software to better manage the land sector. The results have a positive outcome on all 3 other layers again which will result in a virtuous cycle of ever improving results.
